



CONTRACT MODIFICATION NO. 1
BETWEEN THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,
UNIVERSITY of MARY WASHINGTON and CIEE, INC. / iNext
May 31, 2016

In accordance with the terms and conditions of the original Contract, 16-520, "Changes to the Contract" under the University's Mandatory General Terms and Conditions, the following changes have been mutually agreed upon, and will take effect after full execution of this document by both parties.

Relative to the general scope of the above referenced contract, the University of Mary Washington hereby modifies the contract as follows:

Establishing contract policy pricing for inbound plans for international students and scholars under a valid F1 and J1 visa, included only by reference in Contract document:

iNext Global Essential:

Please note that the minimum enrollment is 31 days.

- \$1.25 per day for 10-24 year olds
- \$1.99 per day for 25-29 year olds
- \$3.40 per day for 30-65 year olds
- \$8.00 per day for dependents age 0-65

iNext Global Scholar:

Please note the minimum enrollment is 31 days.

- \$3.95 per day for 10-16 year olds
- \$3.65 per day for 17-34 year olds
- \$9.60 per day for 35-39 year olds
- \$12.70 per day for dependents 0-34 year olds
- \$28.00 per day for dependents 35-39 year olds

iNext Global Scholar Plus with \$0 annual deductible:

Please note the minimum enrollment is 31 days.

- \$6.15 per day for 10-16 year olds
- \$4.95 per day for 17-34 year olds
- \$14.80 per day for 35-39 year olds
- \$18.50 per day for dependents 0-16 year olds
- \$14.80 per day for dependents 17-34 year olds
- \$44.40 per day for dependents 35-39 year olds

iNext Global Scholar Plus with \$250 deductible:

Please note the minimum enrollment is 31 days.

- \$5.70 per day for 10-16 year olds
- \$4.60 per day for 17-34 year olds
- \$13.80 per day for 35-39 year olds
- \$17.10 per day for dependents 0-16 year olds
- \$13.75 per day for dependents 17-34 year olds
- \$41.00 per day for dependents 35-39 year olds

1. In the event that a participant from the University withdraws/defers from a program after the insurance has been issued, reinstated or renewed, iNext will only refund the unused premium portion. If Partner cancels the Policy prior to the effective date, iNext will issue a full refund.
2. Invoicing will occur no later than the 15th of the month following any month with activity. Invoices will be sent via email to Partner.
3. Payments will be due per the Methods of Payment (ref. contract 16-520) and should be accompanied by a copy of the invoice or a list of participants for which the payment is being sent.
4. This agreement may be updated or changed at any time by mutual agreement.
5. The University agrees to the iNext Terms and Conditions as stated below:

Applicable Terms and Conditions:

Refunds: iNext will refund the full value of the policy for insureds upon written notice from the University before the effective date of insurance. If the University wishes to cancel a policy after the effective date, iNext will only refund the University the unused premium portion.

Shipment of cards: No card will be mailed. Once an enrollment is processed, the insured participant will receive its printable insurance card in the email proof of insurance confirmation.

Eligibility for coverage: Individuals under a valid F Visa or J-1 Visa are eligible for coverage as set out in the policy located at www.inext.com/plans/travel-to-usa/. Misrepresentation of the individual's visa type, willful or otherwise, is ground for termination of the policy without refund. Responsibility for determining if an individual insured qualifies for coverage lies with the individual traveler, not with CIEE, iNext or the University.

Leisure Travel: Coverage for leisure travel outside of the covered academic program of study is restricted to 14 days prior to and/or 14 days after the start and conclusion of said program.

All other terms and conditions of the original contract referenced above shall remain in force.

By signing this modification, representatives of each party are certifying authorization to sign and agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of the contract.
